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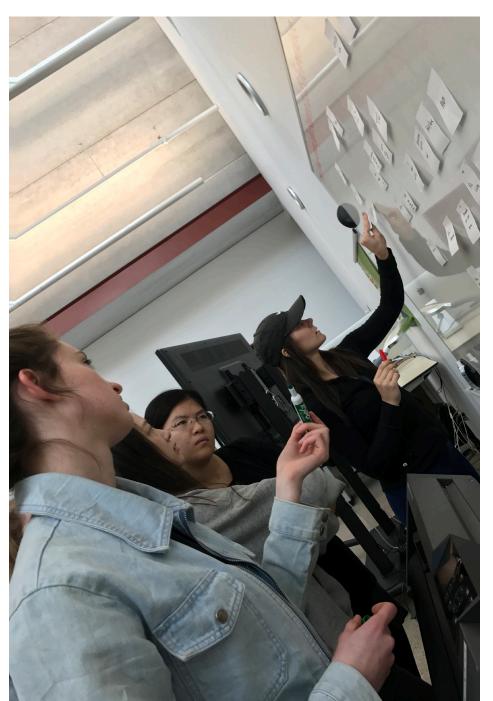
PROJECT STATEMENT

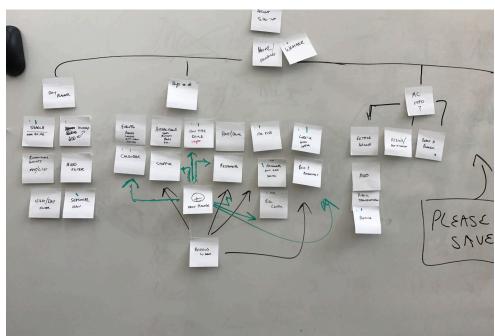

With design provided by the UI student graphic design team, the City can move to the next phase of mobile app development.







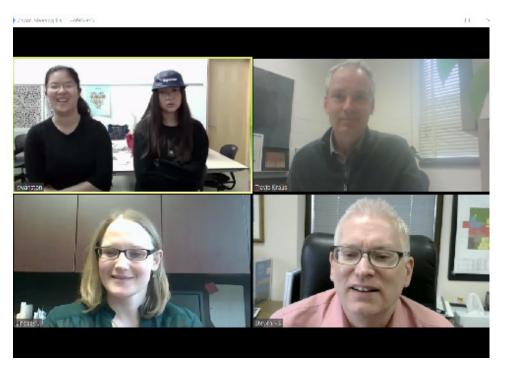
